Jayashree Shinde, Ph.D.

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Dr. Jayashree Shinde is in the teaching profession for the last 26 years. She is currently Director of Teaching Learning Centre established by MHRD-New Delhi under its scheme Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission for Teachers and Teaching". Dr. Shinde has headed the Department of Educational Technology, SNDT University for the past 10 years and has worked as a Faculty in the Department for the last 23 years. Dr. Shinde became Associate Professor in 2006. She teaches Educational Technology, eLearning at masters level which develops skills in Instructional Design, OLD systems, OER development, etc. She is currently guiding 5 PhD scholars mainly working in the fields of M-Learning, Co-operative strategies, Online learning environments, etc. She has been guiding several Post-graduate students in their research.

Dr. Shinde was Standing Committee member of ePG Pathshala, UGC and National Mission for ICT in Education (NMEICT) of MHRD. She is currently on the Advisory Committee of NCERT MOOC and Institutional Advisory Board of Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET), NCERT. She was on Project Review Committees on several projects of NMEICT-MHRD.

Dr. Shinde has a very illustrious academic record. She topped the University at B.Ed. and M.Ed. from SNDT Women's University and has won Gold medals at B.A. from Mumbai University and at HSC. She started exploring the field of Educational Multimedia in 1993 and then pursued PhD in the same field. Her expertise lies in ICT-based training, interactive material development, planning online courses, using constructivist instructional strategies, innovative assessments, etc. She is actively involved in interactive multimedia development projects at the department for more than 13 years. The Department of Educational Technology, under her leadership, has so far developed about 200 hours of interactive eContent for secondary and higher secondary and about 400 hours of eContent for higher education and teacher-training.

She was co-ordinator of the initiative of framing ICT Policy at the SNDT Women's University. Fifteen university teachers have been using blended learning approach under the project in collaboration with Commonwealth of Learning (COL), Canada.

At the SNDT Women's University, she has organized several faculty training programmes on 'Integrating iCTs in Higher Education", "Flipped Learning", "MOOCs" and "OER Development". About 500 faculty from the University departments and affiliated colleges across the country are trained in the training workshops.

Teaching Learning Centre, under her leadership, organized higher education faculty training workshops in the year 2018-19 through face-to-face, online and blended mode covering participants from about 11 States. The centre is also involved in eContent development and research.

Dr. Shinde has worked as a resource person in Bangladesh, Singapore, Slovenia and Mauritius and has taught one course at M.Ed. in the Regina University, Canada. She has worked as a Resource Person in several workshops organised by SNDTWU, DPEP, NCERT, IIT, SIET, DEP-IGNOU, COL, etc. She is course writer for IGNOU. She is reviewer for international and national peer-reviewed journals.
